Complete versions of papers are strongly preferred. Detailed abstracts (several pages in length) will also be considered. For panel proposals, include both titles and abstracts for the panel as well as for each paper within the panel. Since papers and panel proposals are chosen through blind review, names of authors and organizers must be stated only on a separate cover sheet and omitted from the proposals, papers, and footnotes. Please use gender-inclusive language, in accord with the "Guidelines For Non-Sexist Use of Language" published by the APA. (Copies are available from the APA National Office, University of Delaware, Newark DE 19716; 302/831-1112.) Authors and Panel Organizers will hear from the Executive Committee by June 1, 1993. SPEP maintains the right of first review of presented papers for publication consideration in its edited volumes.
